Hudson Chamber of Commerce's new prez just getting settled in

Brian Dunlap had his hands full Monday as he set about to get a grasp on Hudson County's immense and burgeoning business community.

"I'm just getting settled in — there's a lot to digest," said Dunlap on his first day on the job as the president of the Hudson County Chamber of Commerce. "I haven't even turned my computer on yet."

Most recently executive vice president of sales for the Livingston-based CIT Group Inc., Dunlap arrives with an impressive resume. He is also the former executive director of the state chapter of Business Executives for National Security.

"We were looking for a very dynamic professional who had the ability to work with the private and public sector and work with the business community of Hudson County and we believe Brian embodies these

broad-based skill sets and can represent the chamber with the vision we have," said Daryl Rand, vice chairwoman of the executive board.

Dunlap's to-do list is packed. "I really need to revisit the long-term business plan and vitality of the organization as well as getting out and meeting the

membership base," Dunlap said. "I also want to get feedback on the relevance of the Hudson County Chamber of Commerce to the local communities across the cities."

For the three months prior to Dunlap's arrival, Rand and Sharon Pizzutiello, also a vice chairwoman of the executive board and the marketing director at The Jersey Journal, handled the duties of president as volunteers — fielding phone calls for the chamber, managing new membership requests, and meeting with potential new members.

During that time, a search committee sifted through hundreds of applications for the president's job.

John Doyle, chairman of the Hudson County Chamber of Commerce, thinks Dunlap is settling in quickly.

The chamber plans to host a reception for the public to meet Dunlap to be scheduled in coming weeks.
